This funding will be used to

- Improve student outcomes across the curriculum in reading and writing
- NAPLAN Year 3 - NMS 95%, U2B 56%, MSS 420 Year 5 – NMS 92%, U2B 32%, MSS 485
- A-E Data - %C or better > 85%

Our initiatives include

- Embed the focussed and intensive teaching of reading for all students through a sharp narrow approach to the WoodLinks 5 Reads Model within the Australian Curriculum (Guided, Shared, Independent and Modelled Reading)
- Continue to develop capacity of support staff, including teacher aides to work with teachers to provide an explicit reading and writing approach for every student.
- Continue to develop an expert teaching team in reading and writing through a focussed mentor and coaching program and aligned professional learning plan.
- Continue to develop teacher capacity in the analysis and discussion of data and how to use it to improve outcomes for all students, through a case management approach (attendance, whole school testing, NAPLAN, Australian Curriculum A-E data) to inform the teaching of reading and writing for every student, everyday succeeding.
- Continue to develop staff leadership capacity through professional learning communities to share research based learning to improve student outcomes in reading and writing.
